Keynote Address:

- Dr. Revathi Srinivasan's emphasis on the SPICE Methodology (Social, Physical, Intellectual, Creative, Emotional) and the need for inclusion, catering to special needs like Autism, ADHD, and Cerebral Palsy.
- The goal of NEP to enhance teacher-student interaction, improve educator training, and prioritize learning outcomes.
- Quote: "Inclusion is mandatory and not a choice; it is a necessity, and the final outcome of NEP is learning."



Key Takeaways from Panel Discussion:

Core NEP Elements:

- Basic language and numeracy skills from early education.
- Mission "Three R": Reading, Writing, Recitation.
- Flexibility in academic progression with entry-exit options.
- Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) for tracking credits.
- Flexibility through online and self-paced courses.



Implementation Strategies:

- Skill development through visual, auditory, and collaborative tools.
- Inclusion practices like Braille, group activities, and student inclusion cells.
- Curriculum and evaluation adjustments for diverse needs.
- Parental involvement in educational support and engagement



Closing Remarks:

- Emphasize supporting all students, integrating mental health policies, and handling sensory needs through curriculum adjustments.
- Highlight the importance of developing an institutional inclusion policy aligned with NEP 2020.
